The Panhandle Pathway expands and pushes south

Work is now underway to extend the Panhandle Pathway south to Kenneth. Kenneth is approximately ½ mile west of France Park and just south of U.S 24. When complete, the Panhandle Pathway will cover approximately 21 miles. All of this will be on 10 ft wide pavement. It will cross over one river and 5 creeks and covers some of the most scenic land this area has to offer. It will connect the communities of Winamac, Star City, Thornhope, Royal Center and Logansport, Indiana.

If you've already been out on the trail, I am certain you share my feelings. Walking, biking or rollerblading along the countryside is fun. It is hard to explain the sensation of being out on the trail but easy to understand what I'm saying once you've experienced it.
